Policy on the use of artificial intelligence (AI)

Our publication follows the recommendations of the STM (International Association of Scientific, Technical and Medical Publishers) and EASE (European Association of Science Editors) on the use of artificial intelligence in scientific publications.

The use of AI tools to develop, formulate or interpret research results and conclusions is strictly prohibited. All scientific reasoning, proofs and the final conclusion must be the result of exclusively human intellectual work.

Authors are fully responsible for the accuracy, integrity and originality of their work. AI cannot be listed as an author or co-author of the article.

Mandatory Disclosure

Authors must provide a clear disclaimer if any AI tools or AI-enabled tools (e.g., for language editing, data visualization, or literature search) were used in the preparation of the manuscript.

If AI is used, a separate section titled “Declaration on the Use of AI” should be added before the list of references, stating the name of the tool and the nature of its application.
