

POLICY ON PLAGIARISM

Authors who submit materials for publication in the collection “Culture of Word” agree that the article was written by them personally, has not been published anywhere before, and was prepared specifically for this publication.

It is unacceptable to present plagiarism as an original work and submit for publication a previously published article. In cases of detection of the above facts, the authors of the submitted materials are responsible.

Forms of plagiarism include:

- use (literal quoting) of any materials in any volume without indicating the source;
- use of borrowed images, drawings, photographs, tables, graphs, diagrams, or any other forms of graphic representation of information without reference to the source;
- use without written permission of materials whose authors or copyright holders prohibit the use of their materials without special agreement.

All cases of incorrect borrowing (lack of graphic highlighting of the verbatim quoted text in the presence of references to the source; incorrect reference to the source or incomplete composition of its bibliographic description, which prevents its identification; reference to a source other than the first source of the borrowed text without an explicit indication of this fact; absence of references from the text to sources given in the article list; excessive citation, the volume of which is not justified by the genre and goals of the article) are considered individually.

In the event of a proven fact of plagiarism in an article that has already been published, its authors are deprived of the right to be published in all subsequent issues of the collection, and the text itself is removed from the archive of the official website of the publication and from other places of public placement, for which the editorial office of the collection “Culture of the Word” bears responsibility.
