

AUTHORSHIP AND CO-AUTHORSHIP

The journal's authorship policy is in accordance with the rules and guidelines of COPE, Elsevier, and EASE.

All individuals named as authors in the original article are expected to have made a significant contribution to the research. All individuals named as authors must meet the authorship criteria (ISMJE 2022), including:

- making a significant contribution to the conception and methodology of the study, collection, analysis, and interpretation of data;
- participating in writing or revising the article for its intellectual content;
- being responsible for all aspects of the work related to the accuracy or integrity of any part of the article;
- approving the final version of the article.

The editorial board does not limit the number of authors for a particular publication. The authors of the article are not allowed to be changed during its review by the editorial board.

In the event of a dispute between authors regarding their contribution after submitting the article to the editorial office, the editorial office shall suspend work on the article until the authors notify the editors of the final resolution of all issues.

The order of placement of authors in the publication shall be based on a joint decision of the co-authors in accordance with the significance of the contribution of each of them.
